Book: Born Again This Way, by Rachel Gilson

<u>Excerpt of patron comments:</u> "The book starts as sounding supportive of gay Christians but it is not. It reels in the reader thinking it is affirming, but I feel that this book will discourage people from following God. It will make gay Christians feel unwelcome at church.

Did you read the entire book? No

What do you believe is the theme of this book? Convincing gay people that the only way to be Christian and gay is to NOT be gay.

Excerpt of library response: [The author] mostly describes the trajectory of her own sexual feelings and experiences, but also interprets those experiences through the *Gospels of John* and *Matthew* and the writings of *Paul* and *James*. The book makes brief references to some evangelism movements of the 1990s, and current trends in early 21st century Western culture. This is a topic not widely covered in nonfiction publishing or in our collection, but Maryville Public Library does contain other books related to this subject that you may want to examine:
