Limited Use Cards

Non-Resident Northwest Staff and Students

A reciprocal agreement with NWMSU's B.D. Owens Library allows Maryville Public Library patrons to use Owens Library and current University students, staff, and retired staff to use the public library. NWMSU students and staff living or owning taxable property within Maryville city limits may obtain a resident card. NWMSU students and staff that do not live or own property within Maryville city limits may either pay the non-resident fee to obtain a library card, or obtain a limited-use non-resident card free of charge. The non-resident fee waiver associated with this agreement is to be applied exclusively to current University students, staff, and retired University staff. This waiver does not extend to non-resident patrons associated with other NWMSU programs and institutions such as enrollees at Horace Mann Laboratory School.

The limited-use card allows the cardholder to borrow up to five physical items at a time, with the exception of musical instruments. Access to electronic resources is not provided with the non-resident NWMSU limited-use card. All cards carried by NWMSU staff and students are subject to the same application requirements and other terms of use listed MPL's policy documents. NWMSU students wishing to apply for or renew their non-resident limited-use cards must provide verification of their current student status by accessing their student account. NWMSU staff wishing to apply or renew their non-resident limited use card must show their NWMSU ID card.
